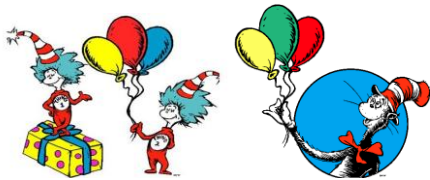
Directors Desk:
